Funding for Community Hall Hire this Autumn and Winter

In 2021 Lochgoil Community Trust secured community funding to pay for hall hire to encourage people to restart activities in the Village Hall after the COVID lockdowns. The funding was used by Argyll Arts, the Parent Council, craft fairs, Mums and Toddlers, Carrick Christmas Fayre, and for the OAP Christmas party.

This Autumn we have approved £4200 of funding to support the usual fundraisers, coffee mornings, craft fairs and community events, but we are also keen to encourage people to test new activities and ideas. So, if you've been thinking of organising a music or leisure activity, an exhibition, learning or networking event, or a social group, then now's the time to give it a try!

Organisers will need to agree bookings with the Village Hall. The Trust will pay the Hall on receipt of the invoice.*

All events must take place or be booked by the end of March 2026, but we may repeat the offer if this initiative is successful.

Providing you have not already received Trust funding for hall hire or have paid the invoice, upcoming events already booked are still eligible.
